Tigist's Story: Fully Embracing Every Opportunity

Tigist used to spend hours each day worrying about her mother Emibet. Burdened by their poor living conditions and the insecurity of their future, one morning Tigist approached HFK staff in tears. Her family was living in a tiny 2x4-foot home made

of plastic tarp which they could barely afford to rent for \$12 month, next to the trash dump. Scavenging at the dump for pieces of metal, wire, and plastic to sell afforded Emibet just enough to pay monthly rent. Their meals were sparse and inconsistent, dependent upon begging or whatever food they could salvage from the trash. Tigist watched her mother struggle through fear and hopelessness as she tried to provide. Without childcare or other means of support, her little brother Biniyam was frequently carried on Emibet's back to the garbage dump where he was exposed to the hot sun and toxic fumes from decomposing garbage.

After learning about Tigist's situation, her family was quickly sponsored and HFK's program has changed the trajectory of their lives. This family is resilient and each one has fully embraced every opportunity given to them. Tigist is actively involved in the HFK soccer program and is excelling in academics at private school. She currently has her photo displayed on the school's banner recognizing her as one of the top-ranking students. Biniyam is also a high achieving student who loves soccer and with exceptional English-speaking skills. Having such proficient language skills adds much promise to his future opportunities. With passion and natural ability, these children continue to immerse themselves in the youth programs, clubs, and friendships that are building a strong foundation for the rest of their lives.

Tigist's mother Emibet has become a weaver in HFK's Independent Basket Weavers' Cooperative. Emibet takes great pride in crafting and selling her high-quality artisan baskets and is so grateful for the purpose and direction she has gained from this group of strong women.

All facets of this family's life have been touched through improved health, education, relationships, and socioeconomic empowerment. Each one has bravely taken many steps to change their circumstances and to invest in their growth. Instead of fearing for what lies ahead and being reliant on insecure and inadequate resources; they now have the skills and confidence to meet their needs, and to plan for their future. We are so proud of them!

Through this Christmas catalogue we hope that many others in Korah will also receive these same gifts that have brought such change to Tigist's family. In turn, we hope they will also bring much Christmas joy to the hearts of those who give.
