




Welcome to the Hope for Korah Christmas Catalogue

Serkalem's Story: A Story of Resilience

Serkalem is one of the first mothers to be sponsored through HFK's Family Empowerment Program. Like so many others in Korah, Serkalem's story is filled with sadness. At a young age she came to Korah on her own, seeking employment, only to end up scavenging on the trash dump and begging on the streets. Serkalem later married, but her husband abandoned her and their four children.



When we first met Serkalem, she was frail with barely enough energy to lift her head. She was nursing her baby Selamawit and trying to provide for her other children. Their home was tiny, dilapidated, and in horrible condition. HFK immediately assessed her high priority needs and began providing their family with much-needed food and clothing. In addition, the family moved to a new home, was seen by a doctor, her son was treated for fungus on his head, and the

children were enrolled in HFK's Berta Breakfast program. Serkalem's situation began to change for the better!

HFK's holistic supports changed the lives of Serkalem's family. More recently, these supports were a pillar of strength in the face of tragedy. Serkalem received relief in the face of COVID-19 and experienced the power of love from HFK staff and the Korah community after the searing loss of her four-year-old son. In May 2020, little Mentisenot tragically fell into a cooking fire and passed away from third-degree burns. Serkalem was able to process her deep sorrow with a counsellor, provided by our Pyscho-Social services. Her daughter Selamawit – who faced trauma from her brother's death – grieved with HFK staff. Selamawit joined private school this past year and has taken great steps of healing as she studies in a supportive environment with good friends. Serkalem and her family exhibit beautiful resilience and are an amazement to those around them.

This year, Serkalem joined HFK's Basket Weavers' Association. This cooperative receives specialized training to hone their skills and helps to set members up for local and international sales. Serkalem's basket sales have been remarkable as her

weaving is meticulous, and her products are of excellent quality. Serkalem is absolutely thrilled by her accomplishments and so are we. She is using the income generated from baskets to start a sewing business. Serkalem took classes in the fall with HFK and plans to sew bed coverings, pillowcases, pajamas, and cultural shirts for kids and adults. Overall, the impact of HFK's programs has brought significant healing and opportunities for Serkalem's entire family.

Serkalem's future will not be the same because of gifts made available through this catalogue! Our desire is that these same gifts will touch the lives of many residing in Korah.
